“BRITISH VALUES” BY THE POP PROJECT

Westfield are being visited by The Pop Project on Monday 10th October. They are a group of experienced teachers and musicians that put on shows to primary schools relating to various subjects. They are coming to us to perform a presentation on British Values, a show that has been requested by various Head Teachers.

The first presentation will be for KS2 children and they will be covering the key areas of democracy, rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs. They will also look at the four countries of the UK featuring costumes, music and dance, and will highlight the great Britons from Winston Churchill to J K Rowling. There will be live music featuring songs to emphasise the key message of tolerance and respect e.g. "Little Help From My Friends", "Love Train", "We Are Family".

After morning break, it's the KS1 childrens' turn. The Pop Project will present British Values in an appropriate way for this age group, looking at the four countries of the UK. There will be lots of learning, singing and fun.



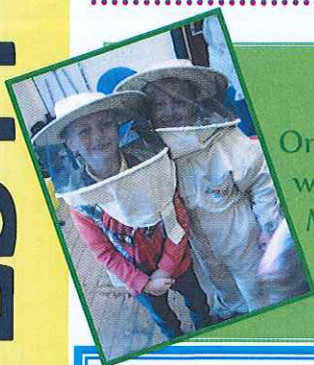
