The Sport Premium is a funding package that was announced by the government to provide schools with additional money over 3 years to support the delivery of PE and school sport. Westfield Primary School has been awarded £8650 based on our pupil numbers and after consulting both the staff and the pupils we plan to spend the money in the following ways:
