

Sports premium impact 2016/2017 (As of April 2017)

Extra-curricular activities.

A wider range of clubs were introduced based on the feedback from parents and children. A hugely popular gymnastics club was set up for both KS1 and KS2. KS1 were targeted in particular to increase participation and a section of the budget was set aside to fund Widnes Vikings sessions. This has increased KS1 participation from 19% in 2015/2016 to 63% in 2016/2017.
