ENGLISH

Story features and sentence structure.

During the first part of the half term, children will explore sentence structure; how to use full stops and capital letters and finding different ways to make are sentences more exciting.

Children will spend the first two weeks reading the story "Owl wants to share at Moonlight School" written by Simon Puttock and Ali Pye. Children will develop the ability to explore a book using the title, blurb and page numbers.

For the second part of half term children will be reading the story "The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark." Children will be focusing on character descriptions and being able to fully reflect on events that have happened in the story.

The Rhyming challenge

Over the half term the children will be completing the Rhyming Challenge as a full class. Everyday the children will learn a new poem and be able to take them home to learn as well. Once the children have completed the challenge they will each receive a certificate.

SCIENCE

Staying healthy.

Children will develop their knowledge of living a healthy lifestyle. Children will be learning why it is important to stay healthy and build up their knowledge of the different food groups.

Children will be exploring different ways to exercise and the benefits of this.

MATHEMATICS

In Numeracy, children will focus on the following objectives;

- Numbers (place value, addition and subtraction.)
- Geometry: Shape.

MUSIC

This half term, children in Larch class will learn about action songs. This will be linked in with their PE lessons through Music and Movement.

ART

Children will develop their techniques and skills of using a range of new materials. We will be completing self portraits and discussing the different shapes we can use in our painting, as well as brush technique.

RE/SEAL

Year One will be looking at who helps us. We will be discussing how different people help us and why. Year One will also be concentrating on how we can be a good friend to others.

PE

Children will be taking part in music and movement. They will be dancing and playing games that will also be developing their phonics knowledge.
