

Beech Class Autumn Term - 1st half overview 'Once Upon a Time'

ENGLISH

Our class book for this half term is Little Red Riding Hood. Year 1 will be looking at how to write stories to help them to write their own traditional tale story. We will also read and compare fiction and non-fiction texts, with the children writing their own information texts about wolves and forests. Throughout the half term, English lessons will focus on the key skills for reading and writing for their year group and practising their handwriting. The children will continue to have daily phonics sessions as well.

SCIENCE

Animals, Including Humans - Ourselves:

During this half term, the class will have a Science focus on themselves. The children will be looking at photographs of humans through life and comparing changes from babies to adults. They will also be looking at the human body and measuring parts of their own bodies, including feet, hands and heads. We will be investigating their senses; touch, sight, smell, taste and hearing.

MATHS

This half term will concentrate on number. We will be learning about the place value of numbers, being able to know one more and one less of numbers up to 10 and adding and subtracting one digit numbers to 10. The children will use numbers and objects to help them to answer one step problems.

HISTORY

We will be exploring ways in which life has changed over time, including clothes, transport, toys and school life.

GEOGRAPHY

The children will be observing the geography of their school and its grounds, creating maps of the school and their journey to get there.

ART AND DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

Year 1 will be making 3D maps of our school and Little Red Riding Hood's journey. The children will also draw self-portraits.

PE

Outdoor sports - RJG Sports.
Indoor PE - practising balances using various equipment.

COMPUTING

Year 1 will learn how to independently use computer programs and the importance of keeping their personal information private.

RE/SEAL

We will focus on looking at the features of traditional church buildings.
S.E.A.L. - New Beginnings.

MUSIC

Learning how to use their voices expressively by singing songs that link to parts of Little Red Riding Hood.

FOREST SCHOOLS

Recapping the rules of the forest, building Houses and making portraits out of natural resources.
