

Beech Class Spring Term - 2nd half overview 'The Wizarding World of Westfield.'

ENGLISH

Our class book this half term will be, 'Lost and Found'. The children will be creating story maps of the book to enable them to create and write their own stories. We will also be learning about the features of diary entries from the prospective of the main characters, with a focus on drama and role-play to act out stories.

Additionally, we will be learning how to use question and exclamation marks and consolidate the use of conjunctions to join sentences. Daily phonics sessions will also continue.

MATHS

This half term, we will continue to order and compare numbers up to 50 and count in 2s and 5s forwards and backwards. The children will then learn about different types of measurements. Firstly, using the terms taller, shorter, longer and smaller to compare the lengths and heights of items in cm with rulers. Next, to weigh items to find out which is heavier and lighter and understanding capacity using the terms full, empty, more and less.

SCIENCE

Everyday Materials - Marvellous Materials

The Year One children will be exploring a range of materials to determine their uses and learning how to compare and group materials. We will be observing and investigating changes, such as melting and freezing.

HISTORY

Looking at changes within living memory, with a focus on 'seaside holidays', comparing the past and present.

GEOGRAPHY

Year One will continue to learn the correct terminology to describe human geographical features in the UK.

ART AND DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

The children will be creating collages. They will also work on basic kitchen equipment skills to cut and prepare food.

PE

Outdoor sports - RJG Sports.
Indoor sports - Cosmic Kids yoga and mindfulness sessions.

COMPUTING

A variety of software will be used by the children to present their work, learning how to use the correct keys and buttons to type in a document and create pictures.

RE/SEAL

We will learn about the celebrations and festivals of Shrove Tuesday, Chinese New Year and Easter.

MUSIC

Year One will learn the correct names of a range of instruments and will use relevant vocabulary to describe music.
