

Beech Class Summer Term - 1st half overview 'STEM - Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics'

ENGLISH

We will be reading the books, 'Knuffle Bunny' and 'Dogger' this half term in our English lessons. The children will look at changing some elements of a story to write alternative versions of their own. We will also be learning about the features of letter writing.

Additionally, we will be focusing on ending sentences using different types of punctuation, practising letter formation and the difference between capital letters and lower case letters. Daily phonics sessions will also continue to ensure the children are secure with all the Phase 5 sounds and tricky words.

MATHS

This half term, we will continue to count in 2s and 5s forwards and backwards, extending this to count also in 10s. The children will learn about multiplication and division, being able to create equal groups by doubling and sharing. Then we will learn about fractions of shapes and amounts, learning how to find a half and a quarter. At the end of the half term, Year One will create grid maps to be able to turn shapes, objects and themselves and will learn the difference between left and right.

SCIENCE

Everyday Materials - Let's Build

The Year One children will extend their learning of materials to be able to name and describe the simple physical properties of a range of materials. To also investigate which materials would be more suitable to make everyday items out of.

HISTORY

Looking at the history of the Royal Family and the changing role of the monarchy over the years.

GEOGRAPHY

We will learn the names and locations the four countries and capital cities of the UK.

ART AND DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

The children will be studying the work by the artist William Morris to create their own floral wallpaper.

PE

Outdoor sports - RJG Sports.
Indoor PE - Cosmic Kids yoga and throwing and catching skills.

COMPUTING

Using software on the I pads to plan and create structures, learning how to input a sequence of instructions.

RE/SEAL

Year One will focus on wedding traditions in the lead up to the Royal Wedding.
S.E.A.L. - Relationships

MUSIC

Key Stage One will be attending the Infant Music Festival in May and will be learning a variety of songs for this.

FOREST SCHOOLS

Creating mud paintings and making a variety of structures and obstacle courses out of natural resources.
