Fiction - Story writing

Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers

- Planning, drafting and evaluating writing
- Using commas in lists, question marks and exclamation marks
- Recognise different sentence types

Children will observe, identify and classify the different uses of everyday materials, recording their observations in the process.
