Autumn Term 1- 2017 Once Upon a Time

Literacy

Our class book is Hansel and Gretel by Anthony Browne. We will look in detail at the structure of the story and create story maps and role play to generate ideas to create our own. Focus will be on including prepositions, expanded noun phrases and adverbs in written work.

Children will focus on newspaper reports for non-fiction text types. We will identify features and write our own about events we experience.

History

Year 3 will be looking at the Stone Age. They will be looking at what life was like during that time and comparing it with the life that we now know.

Science

Year 3 will:

- compare how things move on different surfaces
- notice that some forces need contact between 2 objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance
- observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others
- compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet, and identify some magnetic materials.

Numeracy

I can recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones)

I can compare and order numbers up to 1000

I can use the column method for addition and subtraction.

I can and subtract numbers mentally, including: a three-digit number and ones; a three-digit number and tens; a three digit number and hundreds.

I can estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers.

I can solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

I can recall the multiplication and division facts for the 3 and $4 \times$ tables.

Geography

Children will be looking at where they live in the context of the town, county, country and the world. Map skills will be built upon with the use of compass points.

ART/ DT

Art will be linked to our studies of the Stone Age. We will be making cave paintings and artwork linked to Stonehenge.

RE

Year 3 will study Judaism. We will look at our own family values and traditions, comparing them with those that follow the Christian and Jewish faiths.
