

Autumn Term 2- 2017 One World, One Family.

Literacy

Year 3 will begin the half term looking at poetry from around the world. We will study poems that express the emotions of religious and non-religious festivals from around the globe and compose our own.

Our class book will be *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe* by C.S Lewis. We will pick out the author's techniques and try to replicate these in our own writing. We will understand that the story is a 'finding tale' and adopt the structure to write our own version.

Numeracy

I can count from 0 in multiples of 3, 4 and 8.

I can recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 x tables.

I can write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division for the 3, 4 and 8 x tables.

I can solve different multiplication and division problems, including missing number problems.

I can measure, compare, add and subtract lengths (m/cm/mm).

I can measure the perimeter of 2d shapes.

I can continue to measure using the appropriate equipment and compare simple mixed and equivalent units.

History

Year 3 will build on the study of the Stone Age last half term and now study the Iron Age. Children will develop the concept of chronology and how life changed over time with the discovery of new materials.

Geography

Year 3 will use maps and atlases to locate hills and mountains in the UK and the highest summits in the world. They will learn how mountains are formed and what life can be like for those living in these areas.

ART/ DT

Year 3 will begin a project linked to the study of 'The Tin Forest' book. This will be an ongoing project across 2 half terms which will then be part of a whole school exhibition.

Science

Year 3 will:

- compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties
- describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock
- recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

RE

Year 3 will study Hanukkah in detail. They will look at how and why this Jewish festival is celebrated. They will then compare this to the Christian celebration of Christmas. Other religious festivals will be covered through collective worship assemblies.
