

Summer term 2- 2017 All Creatures Great and Small

English

Our class book is Sheep Pig. We will look at setting descriptions, character descriptions and relationships between characters within the book and study how these are conveyed by the author.

Through our topic we will be reading and writing explanation texts and information texts.

Maths

I can measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml).

I can solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

I can continue to measure using the appropriate tools and units, progressing to using a wider range of measures, including comparing and using mixed units (for example, 1kg and 200g) and simple equivalents of mixed units (for example, 5m = 500cm).

I can interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.

I can solve one-step and two-step questions (for example, 'How many more?' and 'How many fewer?') using information presented in scaled bar charts and pictograms and tables.

History

In year 3 we will be looking the history of the canal system in the UK. We will study how and why it has changed over time with a focus on our local canal system.

Geography

Children will be looking at rivers. We will focus on the famous rivers across the continents and look how they are formed.

ART/ DT

Year 3 will be contributing a piece of artwork to the whole school theme of 'Water' for an exhibition that will take place during the summer term.

Science

Year 3 will be studying plants. The children will identify parts of plants, the life cycle of plants and understand what they need to grow.
