English

Story writing.

We will be looking at Charlottes Webb, we will be looking at descriptive settings along with how to include various techniques when writing own story.

Poetry-

Children will expand on their understanding of poetry by focusing on how poems can be performed. Children will read and recite poetry while discussing vocabulary, structure and language features used to create effects. We shall also incorporate ICT as a way to rehearse and present our poetry.

Numeracy

In Mathematics this term children will be focusing on the following objectives:

- Find the effect of dividing a one or two digit number by 10 or 100, identifying the value of the digits in the answer as ones, tenths and hundredths.
- Round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number.
- Solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.
- Estimate, compare and calculate different measures, including money in pounds and pence.

History.

We look at the history of clothing in Britain from 1066 through to the present day.

Geography

We will look at geographical regions and their characteristics.

ART/ DT

We will create our own landscape using different medias.

Science

We will be looking at animals including humans. We will be focusing upon the digestive system, teeth in humans and food chains.

Computing

We will develop our understanding of interpreting data from spreadsheets along with analysing and exploring different spreadsheets. We will create our own using Microsoft Excel.
