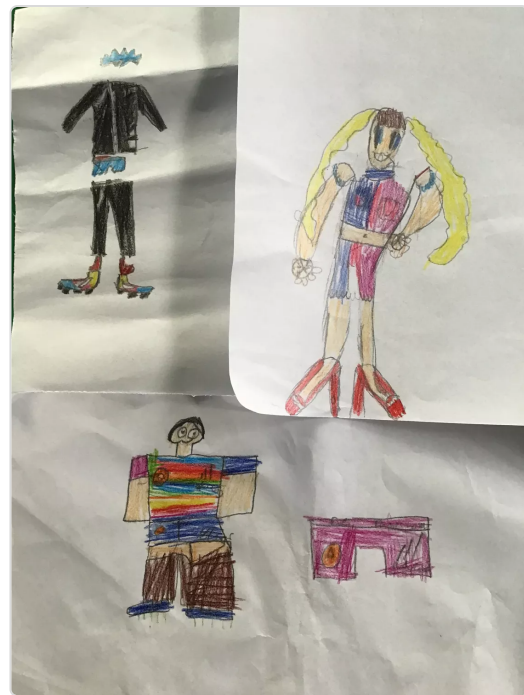
↪ **Willow Class News**

↪ Larch Class News

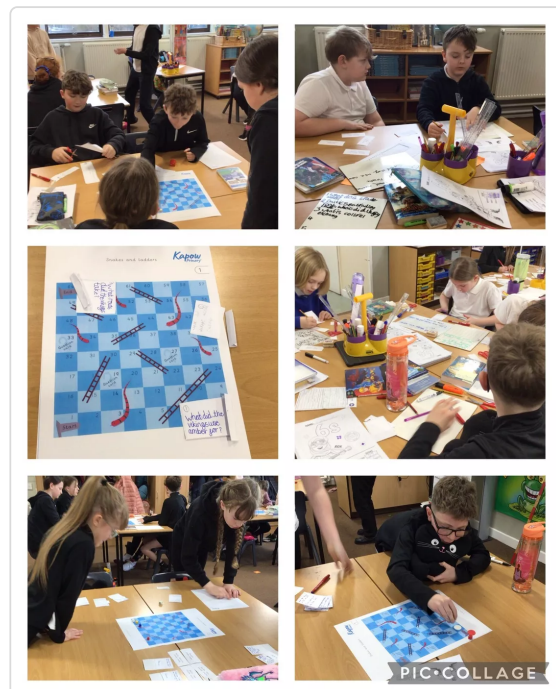
