It's been all about ladybirds in Willow class this week! We have enjoyed reading our story focus by one of our favourite authors this week, 'What the Ladybird Heard' by Julia Donaldson. The children have taken part in lots of early reading activities linked to our focus, including creating their own story telling character puppets, acting out the story with small world figures, drawing their favourite characters in the writing area and writing for a purpose, creating a model ladybird with the play dough and a range of materials.



## ⇨ **Cherry Class**

Indian music in Cherry Class!

We practised playing an Indian 'rag' this week by reading and following our musical notation sheet and even improvised by creating our own using only the notes CDFGB.

We then worked with a partner whilst we added a drone to be played alongside the rag.



## ⇨ **Larch Class**

We have loved making music with the Creative Music Workshop- Y4 used 'Makey Makey' devices to create music using a device (and each other!) while Y5 used Micro Bits to make music with Chromebooks.



## ⇒ Oak Class

The highlights in Oak Class this week have been our Creative Music Workshop, using the chromebooks to make sounds and spending Friday morning in our school forest. We built dens, played hide and seek, climbed trees and used natural objects for obstacle courses. We also had a visit from the Mental Health team, who talked about identifying signs of stress we may be feeling and strategies to help us to become relaxed and calm.

We had great fun in P.E. this week learning some tennis skills and in class, we worked on our fine motor skills with making patterns and cutting and sticking.
