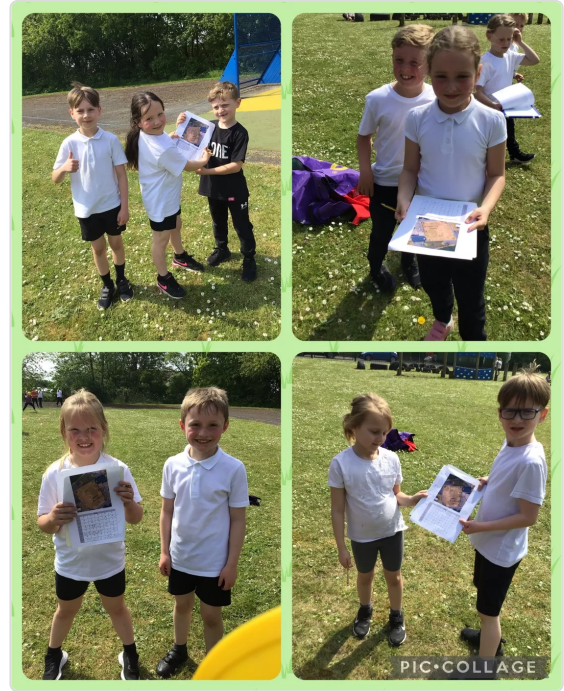
## ↩ Willow Class

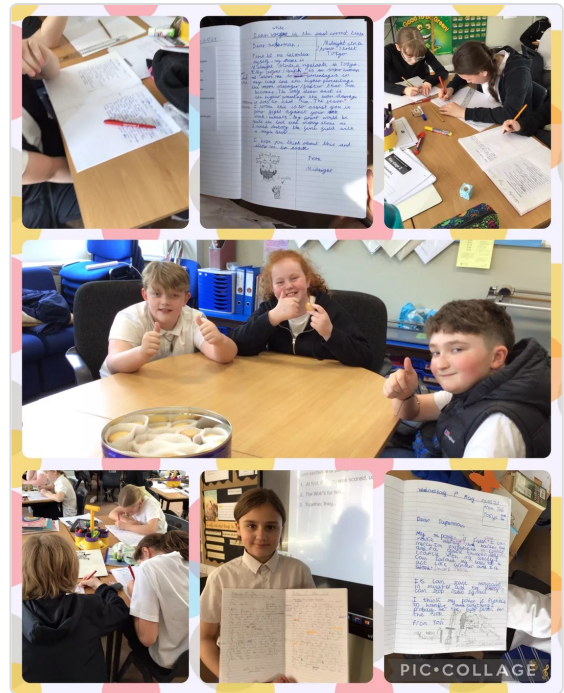
⇒ **Larch Class**
