COVID update

I have updated the school Covid school risk assessment with the main changes being around the isolation period and the introduction of LFT on day 6 and 7 for positive cases. We do update our website regularly so please check for latest guidance. If unsure, please contact the school office and Mrs Shepherd can advise you. Remote learning on Google Classrooms will be available for any children who are isolating.

School Uniform

To help with a sense of community and pride, it is important that the children at Westfield Primary School are dressed smartly and are in the correct uniform. Last week, we sent out a reminder of our uniform expectations. This can also be viewed on our website. In order to reward the children who come in correct uniform we will be running a whole school competition. We have 2 uniform officers, Holly and Alfie in year 6, who will be giving classes, gold, silver and bronze stars depending on how many children are wearing the correct uniform in each class. The class with the most stars will win 2 days of non-uniform during the last week of this half term.

School Improvement

Last term, our journey to continually improve the education for your children focused on developing further the provision for early reading. We are working with the English Hub and through this secured funding for a phonics and reading scheme called Read,Write,Inc. I have led this highly successful scheme before in a previous school and it's proven to accelerate the progress in early reading through a systematic way of teaching. If your child is being taught RWI then you will be invited to a parents meeting so that you can find out more and ask any questions that you may have.

Enhancing our Curriculum

It is extremely important that the children receive first hand experiences and due to the pandemic, over the last two years, trips and outings have been on hold. This term, we will start the garden project at the fire station and make links with Avanti with visits to the train station. We have a planned trip to Martin Mere and staff from Knowlsey Safari Park will be visiting school. It is exciting to be able to get the children out and about again.
