

Home Learning Newsletter

Next week, some of our pupils will be returning to school. School will be very different for those pupils and they will be taught in small groups or 'bubbles' by all of the staff who are in school. As a result of this, we will also be changing the way that we do Home Learning in two stages.

Stage 1: Week beginning 8/6/20

Only a small change this week:

There will only be one blog post this week which will contain a learning grid and English and Maths activities for the whole week.

Teachers will suggest which activities for English and Maths should be done on each day.

Purple Mash blogs and teacher emails will still be open so that we can still keep in touch, but they may not be checked as regularly throughout the day.

Stage 2: Week beginning 15/6/20

New learning packs will be available for children from this point. Information will be sent out to parents and carers to let you know when to come and collect the new packs which will contain learning for English and Maths, rather than being posted online. The packs will contain 2 week's worth of learning and include a new workbook. Collection will be at the end of next week in allocated time slots.

There will also be suggestions for Science and other activities for the fortnight.

All learning packs except for Maths will also be posted on the Westfield blog, along with some resources, such as videos of teachers reading the relevant texts for the English work.

The English and Maths activities will reflect the learning which is going on in school for the returning year groups.

Again, Purple Mash blogs and teacher emails will still be available if any help is needed.

A second pack will then be prepared for the week beginning Monday 29th June.
