The artists will set up a 'rope walk' in the exact location where rope for the shipping industry was made years ago.

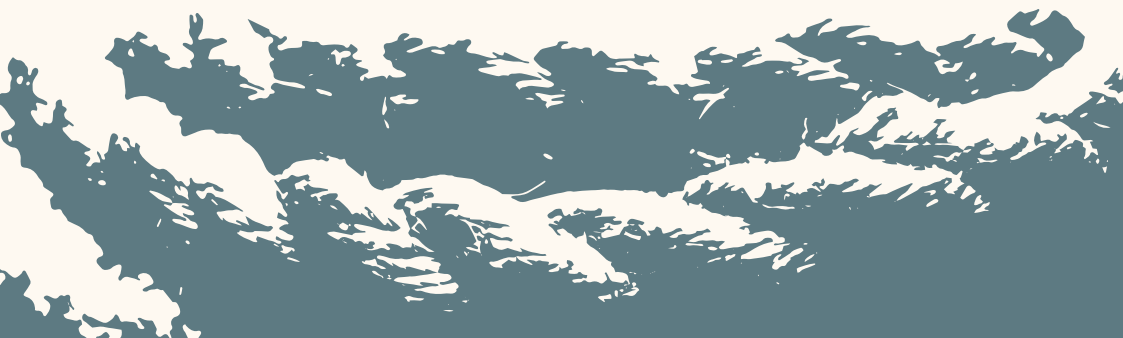
They will make rope with help from local people, twisting hemp in the traditional way. This will be combined with stories linked to historic trades, joining the two to make a unique artwork.
