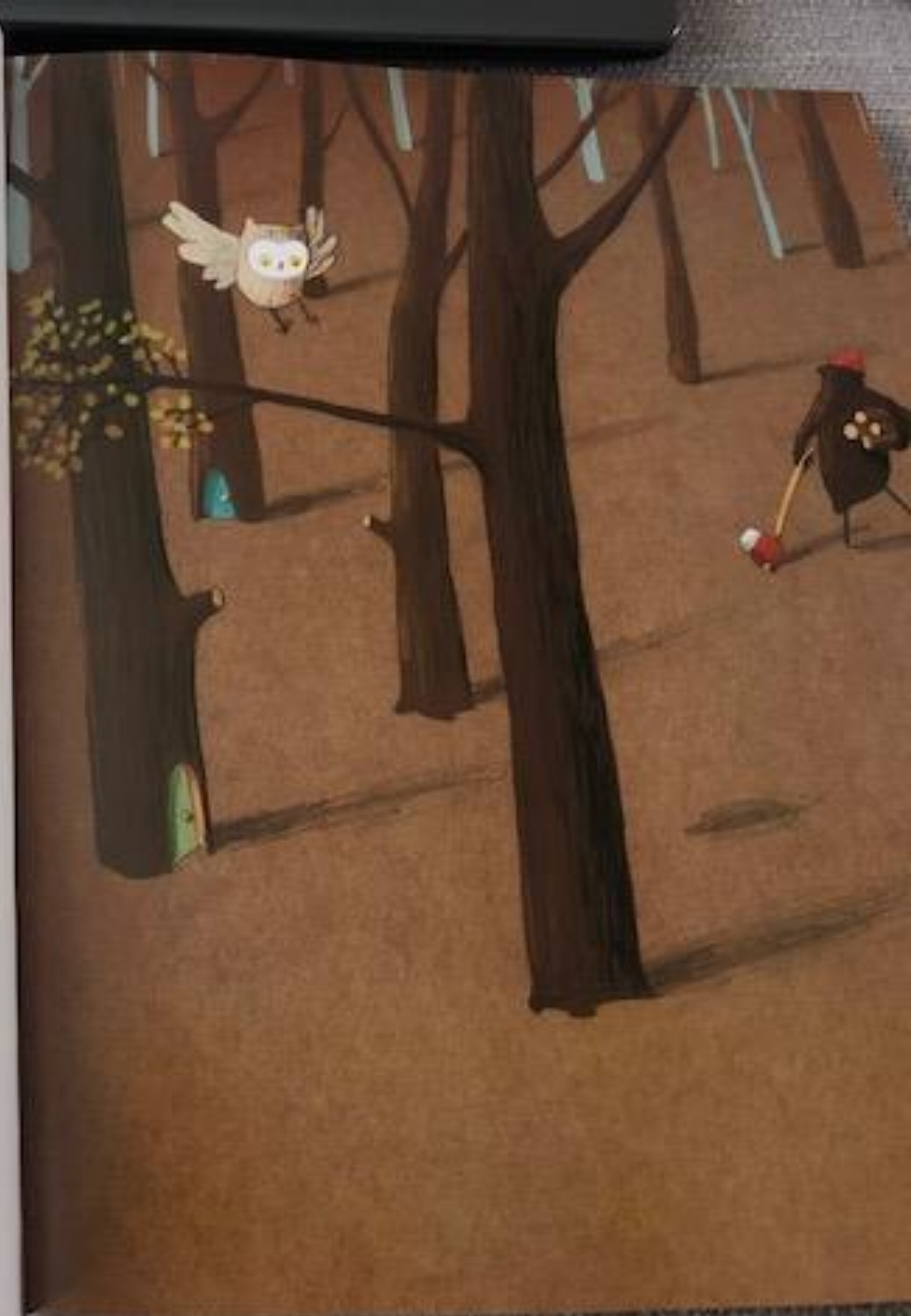

I'll be the detective and you can be the judge.



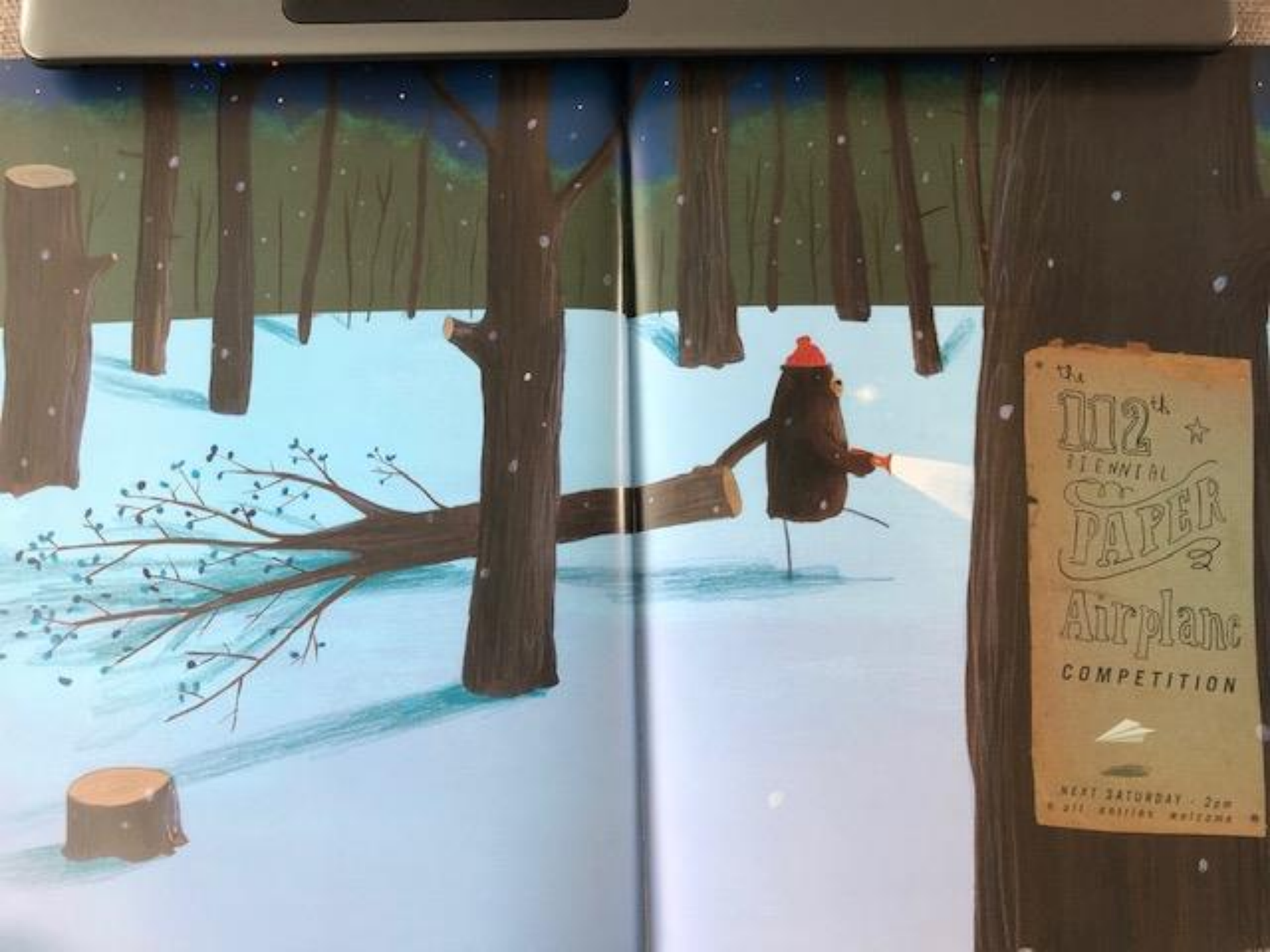
Well, the bear is at the judge.
