At the beginning of term, the Highways Agency visited our school site to monitor parking and the flow of traffic during drop off/pick up times. It has been noted, that there is a significant risk to pedestrians and a parking management system is needed. Over the next few weeks, permanent bollards will be installed on the corners of the road leading up to the school. During peak times, the entry road to school will be for residents only and temporary barriers placed between 8:30am - 9:20am and then at 2:50pm - 3:40pm.

Disabled access to the school will be permitted.
