# Remote Learning

## Remote Learning – Google Classroom

In the event of a class bubble having to close, class teachers will provide remote learning through Google Classroom. Every child has been given their own Gmail address. They are able to log onto their online classroom using these details.

We have created a step-by-step guide on how to access Google Classroom on our school website. This can be found under the 'Remote Learning' tab.

It is a requirement that children access our remote learning platform on the days that they would usually attend school. It is important that good communication between school and parents/carers is maintained during a bubble closure. We ask that all children respond to the daily task briefing on their Google Classroom homepage. This is so that the class teacher can record who has been able to engage with the learning tasks.

In order for children to become familiar with Google Classroom, all teachers will set their holiday homework tasks via this platform. This went live on Friday 23rd October.
