

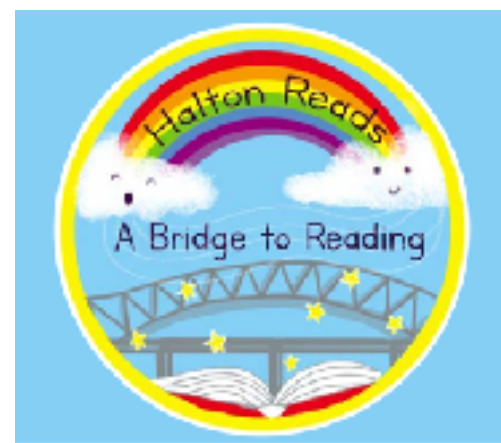

Ice and snow plan

As the winter weather approaches, we will need to change the way the children come in and out of school. On an icy or light snowy day, the KS2 route from the front gate **will be closed**. KS1 route will be gritted and remain open. The back entrance on Crofton Road will be gritted and also remain open. On occasions of severe snow, a plan will be communicated to you on the day.

This will only apply on days where we need to close areas of the school grounds due to the surface being unsafe.

You will receive a notification at 8am if this plan is to be used.

8:40am/3pm

Oak Class will arrive and line up on the 2m markers by the main entrance. They will be collected by a member of staff and enter through the main door. Oak class siblings will go in with them and go to their classroom. At 3pm, Oak class and their siblings will be dismissed from the main entrance. If collecting, parents to wait outside the main gate please.

Cherry class will arrive and follow their normal route down the KS1 one-way route. Any KS2 siblings will be greeted by a member of staff on the playground, who will direct them to their class entrance, ensuring social distancing. At 3pm, Cherry class will be dismissed as normal and siblings can be collected from the KS2 playground.

8:50am/3:10pm

Maple class will arrive and line up on the 2m markers by the main entrance. They will be collected by a member of staff and will enter through the main door. Any siblings will go in with them and go to their classroom. At 3:10pm, Maple class and their siblings will be dismissed from the main entrance. Parents/carers to wait on the 2m markers on the top carpark please.

9am/3:20pm

Larch class will arrive and line up on the 2m markers by the main entrance. They will be collected by a member of staff and will enter through the main door. Any siblings will go in with them and go to their classroom. At 3:20pm, Larch class and their siblings will be dismissed from the main entrance. Parents/carers to wait on the 2m markers on the top carpark please.

9:10am/3:30pm

Birch class will arrive and line up on the 2m markers by the main entrance. They will be collected by a member of staff and will enter through the main door. Any siblings will go in with them and go to their classroom. At 3:30pm, Birch class and their siblings will be dismissed from the main entrance. Parents/carers to wait outside the school gates please.

Willow class will arrive and follow their normal route down the KS1 one-way route. At 3:30pm, Willow class will be dismissed from the classroom as normal and siblings can be collected from the main entrance.

Parents/carers with children at playgroup

If arriving from the front, you will follow the KS1 one-way system and then turn left out of the gate by the woods. You will enter playgroup at the back by the astroturf. If you enter school from the back gate on Crofton Road, your plan has not changed.

It is really important that you arrive at the correct time. We must not have bubbles crossing and children waiting.

As always, 2m distance at all times, move off the school grounds swiftly and stay in your family bubbles please.
